Participation in CPACC and/or community events and activities.

SELECTION CONSIDERATIONS

Nominee contributed a needed service to CPACC and/or the community.

Nominee was active and significantly involved with the CPACC and/or community.

Nominee initiated new programs or activities that had a positive impact on the CPACC and/or community.

Nominee accomplished desired results and worked toward the Chamber mission (see footer).

The activity or service produced positive changes that provided examples for other groups/individuals.

Amount of time devoted to the activity or service was significant.

Nominee overcame unusual challenges.
