Basic Membership Will give you parking and voting only for \$15

Red level Pass is \$50. For one person to enter all VARSITY home Football games only. Free parking with designated parking area, 10% off purchases from the Spirit Shack, voting rights, and we're working on a WFFootball stadium cushion.

White level Pass

\$25 For JV & Freshman Home games only. 10% off Spirit Shack Purchases. QBC Membership is included. You save \$7

For all home Football games. \$75 For one person to enter all VARSITY home Football games only.
