

JOSEPH JOHN ANTOSZCZYK

1915 - 1991

Joseph J. Antoszczyk, age 76, of Lake Township near Caseville, passed away Friday, Feb. 15 at Huron Memorial Hospital, Bad Axe following a brief illness.

He was born Sept. 8, 1915 in Detroit, son of the late Stanley and Josephine (Kaftaniak) Antoszczyk. He was united in marriage to Anne Dzierlatka in Detroit on June 22, 1940. She preceded him in death on June 20, 1969.

Mr. Antoszczyk owned and operated Antoszczyk's Market in Detroit until its closing in 1980. He also owned the New Elks Bar on Chene in Detroit, selling it in 1980 and retiring to his summer home in Lake Township.

He was a member of St. Roch Catholic Church, Caseville and the Fraternal Order of Eagles, Aerie #3690, Caseville. Surviving are his daughter, Joanne (Evert) Eklund of Sterling Heights; three grandchildren; his brother, Stanley (Delores) Anders of Detroit and dear friend, Miriam Pitt of Caseville.

A daughter, Judy; his son, Joseph and his brother, Zigmund, preceded him in death.

A Funeral Mass was conducted Monday, Feb. 18 at 11 a.m. at St. Roch Catholic Church. Rev. Fr. Richard Meyette, pastor, officiated with burial in Mt. Olivet Cemetery, Detroit.
