Another Saturday, another crazy finish. In the Ole Miss-Arkansas game, the Hogs were down 52-45 in overtime and were facing a 4th and 25. Brandon Allen completed the pass to Hunter Henry but when he realized he was going to be tackled short of the first down, he blindly and wildly threw the ball backwards where Alex Collins picked it up and ran for the 1st down. From there Arkansas scored the TD and instead of kicking the extra point and extending the game, Bret Bielema decided to go for 2 and the win. On the first attempt, Allen was sacked but a facemask penalty allowed Arkansas a second chance and Allen plunged into the endzone from 1 yard out for the amazing win.

In other action last week, Clemson showed that they are the team to beat in the ACC after their 10 point victory over Florida State. We said last week, that Nebraska was capable of beating Michigan State and sure enough, the Huskers came through with a big win over the Spartans 39-38, when Tommy Armstrong Jr threw a 30 yard TD pass with 17 seconds left on the clock. Alabama's Derrick Henry rushed for 210 yards and 3 TD's in Alabama's 30-16 win over LSU. Oklahoma State looked awesome in their dominating 49-29 win over previously undefeated TCU. Iowa came away with a hard fought 35-27 win over the high scoring Indiana Hoosiers. Oklahoma has been on fire since their stunning loss to Texas as they rolled to an easy 52-16 win over Iowa State. Don't look now but UNC's football team is clicking on all cylinders as they blasted Duke 66-31

On Nov 4th, it was announced that Atlanta's Mercedes-Benz Stadium (2018), Santa Clara's Levi's Stadium (2019) and New Orleans' Mercedes-Benz Superdome (2020) would host the National Championship Game in those years joining Arlington, TX (2015), Glendale, AZ (2016) and Tampa, FL (2017) that had already won the right to host the title game. That guaranteed that the first 6 National Championship Games (2015-2020) would be held in the southeast, southwest or western regions of the United States. Bill Hancock, the Executive Director of the College Football Playoff stated that he wants to move the game around the country but that the bids were better in the cities that were awarded the title games. Here at THE BLITZ™ we're in favor of cities, like Minneapolis (US Bank Stadium), Detroit (Ford Field) and Indianapolis (Lucas Oil Stadium) hosting title games in the future because it's just the right thing to do. OKLAHOMA AT BAYLOR



Bob Stoops and his Oklahoma Sooners (8-1) travel to McLane Stadium in Waco to take on Art Briles and his undefeated Baylor Bears (8-0) in a pivotal game in the Big 12 with both conference and playoff implications at stake. This game will be televised nationally on ABC at 8:00 EST.

Baylor freshman QB Jarrett Stidham looked solid in his very first college start after replacing the injured Seth Russell last Thursday night at Kansas State. Baylor leads the nation in scoring but Oklahoma has a solid defense and it won't be as easy in this game as it's been all season long. Baylor RB Shock Linwood has gained over 1,000 and if he can have success on the ground vs the Sooners, it should take some of the pressure off of Stidham. OU quarterback Baker Mayfield comes into this game having passed for 25 TD's while throwing just 4 picks all season long but the Sooners can run the ball as well with Samaje Perine leading the way. Mistakes like penalties and turnovers will probably decide this game. Based on the way Stidham played in his first start, it shows that he's capable of playing at a high level and the Baylor system fits his skill set just fine.

Oklahoma won the first 20 games of this series and leads the all-time series 21-3 but Baylor has won 3 of the last 4 including the last 2 years having out scored OU 89-26 in the process. We expect this to be a great game and believe it could go either way, but we think that Oklahoma will find a way to come away with the win.
