RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING BENEFIT ASSESSMENT RATE FOR 2017-2018

WHEREAS:

Pursuant to Resolution No. 2011-01, the Board of Directors of the North Delta Water Agency approved the Assessment Roll for the Agency. The Assessment Roll established the maximum rate for parcels with an assessment valuation of 1.0 (hereafter the "base rate") at \$3.08 per acre and an upper limit of \$8 on the minimum assessment per parcel. Annually the Board adopts assessment rates and a minimum assessment per parcel up to but not to exceed the aforementioned limits.

WHEREAS:

Resolution No. 2011-01 states that the Board of Directors may increase the maximum assessment rates and the upper limit on the minimum assessment per parcel by the greater of 3% per year or an amount equal to the annual change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI). If the Board decides to increase the maximum and minimum assessment per acre at less than the greater of 3% or the CPI for a given year, any percentage change in excess of that actually imposed may be cumulatively reserved and added to the annual percentage change for future years.

WHEREAS: The Board increased the maximum assessment rates or the minimum assessment for the 2016-17 fiscal year. The CPI for that year was ____. WHEREAS: The Board has reviewed and adopted a budget for the 2017-2018 fiscal year, including a reasonable reserve for contingencies. BE IT RESOLVED: The maximum assessment rates are increased by ____%, making the base rate \$____, and the remainder to vary in accordance with the schedule of rates set forth in the Assessment Roll.
