

St. Paddy's Day Pot 'O Gold


Tips and Suggestions

Use this Pot of Gold to store flashcards, wall cards, writing prompts, or collect class rewards. There are lots of things you can do with it!

Print the pot (pages 2-5) on four sheets of cover stock or tag. If you have access to a large format printer you can print the **Ledger Size** Pot O' Gold instead **(file c)**. Then you won't have to tape it together.

Letter Size (file b): Trim off the bottom margin and lay the pieces so the front is up side down and the back is right side up. Tape the two pieces with book tape, so that they will fold together (see picture). Laminate and cut them out.

Both Sizes: The front has been made a little larger than the back piece so that it will bow out a little. Fold the front and back together and bring the front edge of the pot rim in line with the back edge. Staple it in place. Pinch the front a little at the center (along the vertical tape line) so it will bend out, then staple the other side at the pot rim. This should give you a nice little pot that is flat on the back but rounded in the front. Staple it to the wall making sure you put a couple of staples on each side to keep the cards from falling out.
