CLASS NOTES

In February the children did activities with the color red and the heart and circle shapes. We sang songs about valentines and bubble gum! We experimented with mixing colors. We found out that the silly groundhog saw his shadow and that there would be six more weeks of winter.

The Thursday class had a wonderful day celebrating the Chinese New Year. We learned that red is considered a lucky color and that 2017 is the year of the rooster. We made lanterns and had a lantern parade. We made Chinese fans and used chop sticks to transfer cotton balls from a dish to a cup. For President's Day we learned about Washington, Lincoln and Trump as presidents. We learned about our money having pictures of our earliest presidents on it. We learned the words coins and bills relating to money. We had a patriotic parade throughout the building.

In March the Thursday class will begin using lummi sticks (a type of rhythm stick) during their movement and music time. The students will finish the tooth unit by doing a very fun experiment with eggs. We will introduce the "Starry Night" by Vincent Van Gogh to the class during our Night unit.

All of our students enjoy being classroom helpers. They are quite dependable and follow through tasks quite nicely for their ages.

In March our classes will be doing activities with the colors yellow, green and purple. We will be doing units on night time and snakes. We will discuss St. Patrick's Day and the season of spring.
