Helen L. Holland of Sebewaing died Thursday morning, July 25, at Tendercare of Cass City, at the age of 100, following a brief illness.

She was born in Helmstedt, Germany, on Feb. 2, 1896, the daughter of Henry and Henrietta (Zach) Rueger. She came to the United States as a child.

She was married to Aaron Holland on Sept. 9, 1914, in Huron County. He preceded her in death on July 26, 1957.

Mrs. Holland was a longtime member of St. John Lutheran Church, Kilmanagh, and presently was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church of Sebewaing.

Surviving are four daughters and spouses, Ruth and Norman Hensel, Pearl Salter and Darlene and Gerald Haist, all of Sebewaing, and Dora and Frederick VanSlover of Mt. Clemens, nine grandchildren, 16 great-grandchildren and one great-great-granddaughter, and many nieces and nephews.

Two sons, Ralph and Nelson Holland, two brothers, August and Henry Rueger, two sisters, Margaret Gettel and Rose Nimitz, and one grandson, James VanSlover, all preceded her in death.
