Supervisor May opened with the Pledge of Allegiance; all were thanked for attending the meeting. [There were no questions or comments from the audience.]

Zoning – report in packet. [Nothing new this month]

Highway Superintendent Report We have been plowing and sanding, last week of February mixed sand / salt. This week surfacing, we had a brake issue in 201. The pickup had a broken wire. Put new tires on 205. We are starting to line up projects for spring: 1) Wilder Road 2) Change the culvert on that road. Truck 201 the box is rotted off. Looking to repair, a new box estimate is \$4,800. We have been chasing water, all of the staff are good.

Town Clerk Report: Our Town website visits for February 2021 was 1396. The Towns total revenue for the month of February 2021 was \$210.00, \$90.00 for dog licenses, \$10.00 for copy of marriage license and \$110.00 for Registrar fees. We had 6 dog renewals and 2 new dog licenses. To the general fund, \$148.00, Dogs were \$28 and 120.0 for registrar fees. We disbursed \$50.00 to Wyoming County, \$12.00 to Ag and Markets for dogs. Permission requested to purchase Williamson Law Soft ware for Town Clerk, it will help with accurate intake of monies and non-duplicates of dog licensing. On a motion by Mr. Ahl, seconded by Mr. Flint to purchase the Town Clerk software from Williamson Law. Ayes [4] May Boxler Flint Herman Ahl. Noes [0] Carried

Supervisor May discussed that the Town and Invenergy were given in recognition of generous support to the 4-H camp Wyomoco, on behalf of the Cornell Cooperative Extension of Wyoming County.

Supervisor May discussed that Mr. DiMatteo, Spectrum, Mark and herself will be continuing to discuss the contract.

Supervisor May requested a motion to approve the 2021 Highway Fund Bills: Abstract #3 Vouchers #22 through #43 totaling \$64,436.71. A motion was made by Mr. Boxler, seconded by Mr. Flint to approve the payment of the Highway Fund bills. Ayes [4] May Boxler Flint Herman Ahl. Noes [0] Carried
