BAPTISM OF THE LORD

JANUARY 17 - MEMORIAL OF SAINT ANTHONY, ABBOT: Anthony was born into a wealthy Christian family in Egypt about 251. Both his parents died while he was a teenager and Anthony gave away his inheritance and became a hermit. After years of solitude, he emerged to gather the ascetics who had followed him into a 'community'. This was the beginning of Christian monasticism. Anthony died on January 17, 356, well-known for his holiness, wisdom and asceticism.



All Masses have been cancelled and all churches closed until further notice. Father Hearn will celebrate Mass privately on a daily basis with intentions from our Mass book and he will be available if needed for personal pastoral care of parishioners.

Sunday Theme

Poday, as Jesus is baptized, we have another epiphany (manifestation) or **1** theophany (the revelation of God to humanity) when Jesus is named the Beloved Son of God. In actuality, Jesus had no need of the Sacrament of Baptism since he had no sin. However, in submitting himself humbly to the baptism of John the Baptist, Christ provided an example for the rest of us. Jesus' baptism marks his initiation into public ministry. With this celebration we are called to recommit ourselves to follow in the footsteps of Jesus. Initiated into the Church through our baptism, we too are commissioned to proclaim Good News to the world by the way we live.



****************** **ORDINARY TIME** (January 10 - 28, 2022)

Indinary Time encompasses that part of the liturgical year that does not fall within the distinctive seasons of Advent, Christmas, Lent, and Easter. The Catholic Church celebrates two periods of the year as Ordinary Time: the first following the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord and continuing until the Tuesday evening before Ash Wednesday; the second following Pentecost Sunday until the evening before Advent. There are about 33 or 34 Sundays in Ordinary Time, depending on the year. In actuality, however, there are fewer 'Sundays of Ordinary Time' because major feasts honouring the Trinity, Corpus Christi, Christ the King, and others replace a particular Sunday of Ordinary Time. It is important to remember that Ordinary Time celebrates "the fullness of the mystery of the Lord Jesus". During Ordinary Time "the people of God offer praise by celebrating the Paschal Mystery of the Death and Resurrection of Jesus".

CHURCHES CLOSED

n December 29, 2021, we received a letter from Bishop Anthony Daniels informing us that effective immediately all churches in the Diocese of Grand Galls were to be closed for inperson celebrations of Mass. This was in response to being notified that at two Christmas Eve Masses in the Diocese someone had tested positive for COVID-19. Funerals and weddings are permitted with limited capacity (50) or 25% capacity whichever is less. A dispensation from attending Sunday Mass remains in effect and we are encouraged to participate in Sunday Mass through live-streaming.

The MEMORY TREE OF LIGHTS Mass which was scheduled for Wednesday, January 5, 2022 has been postponed until the churches in our Diocese reopen.
