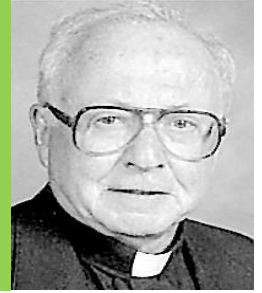

2020 ENTERTAINMENT BOOK FUNDRAISER

Council 14995 will be selling the 2020 Entertainment books for \$30 again this year. This fundraiser needs to generate \$3000 to fund the four \$750 scholarships that will be awarded in the spring of 2020 to four graduating eighth graders from St. Charles Grade School that will be attending a Catholic high school in the fall of 2020. This means that for this fundraiser to meet budget, this fundraiser must sell 215 books at St. Charles School, to members of the council, and to the St. Charles parish community in order to have a profit of \$3000. Last year this fundraiser only sold a total of 174 books. This means that this fundraiser must sell 40 more books this year. I am therefore, asking all members of the council to seriously consider purchasing and/or selling a 2020 Entertainment Book. Cincinnati and Columbus books will also be available to purchase for \$30. These Entertainment books make excellent Christmas gifts. You will get your money back if you only use the book 3 or 4 times. Books will be available in October at the business meeting, at the church office, and at the school office. Thanks in advance for helping us make this a successful fundraiser.

Don't forget to bring your empty ink and toner cartridges to the meetings. We recycle them via Staples and receive \$2 for each cartridge. We use this Rewards money to purchase office supplies for the council.

Football Fund Crazr Sweepstakes

It's time for the 2019/2020 Campaign! We're talking some nice dollars below that mean a lot to our Council. Please support this again. We were one of the highest Councils in the State last year.

2018/2019 Council and Individual Proceeds

Our Council received **\$1,216** cash as a result of selling these tickets.

Our Council received **\$407** credit against our State per Capita fees.

Ed Dudzinski, Pete Petrin, Jamie Gehring and Bob Uchtman won a combined **\$650**.

Tickets are \$20 each. This is a 10-week program following the NFL from October 27 through December 29. If we sell 228 tickets, we'll receive \$9 back per ticket for a total of \$2,052 cash and an amount to be determined for the State per Capital fees credit. And hopefully we'll have a number of Knights win too.
