Horse Mt. Project- HLT requested information about determining the Horse Mountain property boundaries. DW will contact the Williamsburg Conservation Commission for the survey information.

Impact of Dogs on town Properties-In response to an inquiry we discussed the possible impact of loose vs leashed vs no dogs on town properties. WWTC encourages multi use of our trails and we have a dog policy in place. Town properties are under the jurisdiction of different town departments. Each department should develop its own policy.

Historic Dam Trail- PJ distributed sign templates for *caution* and *closed in winter* signs for placement at the trail. The signs have been ordered. Waysides are in the design and production stage to be ready for installation by May 16<sup>th</sup> trail opening.

First Day Hike at the Briar Hill Conservation Area was cancelled due to intense cold and wind.
