

PROGRESS CONTINUES TO BE MADE ON PRAYER SHRINE DEDICATED TO THE MYSTERIES OF THE ROSARY
El Santuario de Los Pobladores – The Sanctuary of the Settlers, under the leadership of Alfonzo Abeyta, board member, and the cooperation of its members have been working very hard this past summer making adobes to get the shrine project going. We invite supporters of this undertaking to stop by the site to see the progress made. Adobe walls fashioned by hard work and zealous determination have gone up and completed. Adding additional warmth and appeal, a large beautiful rustic gate is adorning the entrance to the shrine with three smaller gates at the exits. Bronze art for the individual nichos has also been completed and will be mounted next spring.
At the entrance to the shrine, there will be an 8 foot bronze statue of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Seven surrounding bronze statues of our mission patron saints will bolster the spiritual presence of our faith. Adobe dedication plaques and merchant donor plaques will also be in place. Landscaping and a security system will complete the project. The committee estimates that additional funds to complete the project will be approximately \$250,000. The board of El Santuario is deeply grateful for your support of our work with your donations and prayers.

**MASS READING
REFLECTION**

**January 23, 2022
First Reading
Neh 8:2-4a, 5-6, 8-10
[God’s Law]**

This reading deals with a time when the Babylonian exile has ended and many of the cap-tives have returned home—only to be met with the frustrations of the reconstruction. Word filters back to those who remained in Babylon, and two influential Jews return to aid the recon-struction. One is Ezra the priest. The other is Nehemiah the cupbearer of the Persian kind, who eventually rebuilds the walls of Jerusalem. Today’s passage describes the reestablish-ment of religious worship in the restored and repopulated city. Notice that the word *is not only read, but also explained and agreed upon* by the listeners’ “Amen.” Ezra, reading and explaining the Bible, prefigures Jesus in the syna-gogue of his hometown (Gospel).

**Second Reading
1 Cor 12:12-30 or 12:12-14, 27
[One Body]**

Paul brings out our diversity in unity. We are one and responsible for one another. Each one of us should do his/her part of the job as well as possible and so contribute to the well-being of all. Apply this to your Christian life-style as you live it with your fellow Christians. You should not try to “go it alone.” Such an approach never works. As is true for members in the family and for religious in community life, we need our mutual inspiration. This involves giving and taking. Apply this also to the committees of your parish council. They can call upon a diversity of talents. In what field are you proficient? Your priest is the teacher (preacher), but you may be particularly adept in the areas of showing hospi-tality, making strangers feel at home, or in some other area that is just as important!

Theme: God’s Living Word in the Bible

The word has a formidable impact. Campaign-ing politicians, lawyers in court, and preachers of re-vivals are aware of its magic power and work mira-cles with it. The word is conveyed both in its written and in its spoken form. A book like Hitler’s *Mein Kampf* (“My Struggle”) led millions into the calamity of World War II, while the sermons of Bishop Sheen on television showed the path of righteousness to a multitude of listeners.

The best-seller par excellence, which remains unsurpassed by any book, is the Bible. Before Christ, it was known as the Torah or the Law. In our tradition, with its Christian interpretation added (New Testament), it became known as the Bible, from the Greek, “Biblos” —the inner bark of the papyrus, paper book, hence, the Book! Today’s First Reading and Gospel cold be qualified as “the Bible on the Bi-ble.”

What does the “Good Book” mean to you? Do you read/listen with faith? Bible reading just for in-formation’s sake becomes boring since many passag-es are already known to us. Bible reading should be done always prayerfully and meditatively, applying God’s word to our own situation.




