

MARVIN FLUEGGE

1924 - 1996

Marvin H. Fluegge, 72, died at his home in Junction City, Oregon, Thursday, Sept. 12 after a long illness.

Mr. Fluegge was born June 5, 1924 to Karl and Ottile (Fritz) Fluegge in Anaheim, Calif.

He and Luana Powell were married July 28, 1951 in Anaheim. They lived in Anaheim and Orange, California, and in 1964, moved to a farm in Junction City.

He and his wife, and often with their children, made frequent visits to his relatives in Huron County and the Detroit area. During World War II, he was a member of the Merchant Marines.

Surviving are his wife Luana; four daughters, Kathleen (Steven) Swart, Carol Ann (Rodney) Laub, Sandra (Gary) Pomeranika, Mary (William) Best III, and one son, Casey (Becky) Fluegge; 11 grandchildren, and many cousins.

He was preceded in death by a six-year old daughter, Sharon Lee.

Funeral services were held Monday, Sept. 16 at the Messiah Lutheran Church in Eugene, Oregon, where they are members.
