Whopper Board Reminder

From the Whopper Board rules:

To be eligible to participate in the Tournaments, a club member must support the club by participating in one Club sponsored fishing event during the eligibility period. Any member not participating will have all of their entries removed from the records for that year.

A Club sponsored event includes any of the Club Saltwater Charters or a Freshwater Event sponsored by the Club.

WHOPPER BOARD/ANGLER OF THE YEAR CHANGES FOR 2021.

At the most recent Board meeting held in October there were some changes made to Angler of the Year and the Whopper Board rules/outcomes for 2021.

As below:

- 1. Fish submitted for Whopper Board and Angler of the Year must be of legal size per the State of California DFW Regulations, or where ever the fish was caught including other states or countries.
- 2. Any fish caught on a Club Saltwater Charter or Club Freshwater Fishing Event will get double points towards Angler of the Year. There will not be double points for the Whopper Board.
- 3. Prizes for the Whopper Board's First, Second and Third places will be reduced in 2021 to \$50, \$25 and \$10 values.

Regarding #1, it was noted that the Whopper Board rules do not state this so it was added beginning in 2021.

The Board would like to increase member participation in the Club Events and felt that #2 above could promote that.

As for the third change listed, current membership numbers need to increase to support our current memberships costs. The funds for the Whopper Board come from the Membership dues. Our costs have gone up and Membership dues have not. While we have gained new members every year, some other members are no longer fishing or are no longer active in the Club. We need everyone to promote membership.

2021 Fred Hall Shows Prediction

While 2021 is the 75th Anniversary of the Fred Hall Shows, it definitely will not be like any other show.

First, while the 2 shows are slated for March 3-7 in Long Beach & March 25-28 in Del Mar, it likely isn't going to happen that way. Show planners doubt that Los Angeles will allow an event that early in the year, so alternate plans have been made.

The Del Mar Show will likely happen first, and it will likely be early April before that happens. Even then it will be 98% outdoors with many precautions, included limited entrance to the larger displays. Dining tables will be 10 feet apart.

The Long Beach Show may not be possible even in the second quarter of 2021 in Los Angeles County.

There is a contingency plan to hold it at Angel Stadium in May. Once again all outdoors with 20 foot aisles, all booths separated and larger booths closed off with limited numbers allowed at a time.

This is directly from Bart Hall. Stay tuned in 2021 for updated information.
