Congratulations on being selected to join Addison United Soccer Club's (AUSC) Travel team for the 2014-2015 seasonal year! AUSC hopes that this will be a rewarding and fun year of soccer for you and your family. It is AUSC's philosophy to keep the development of the player as its primary focus. Success is not measured with wins, but with the development of your child. Once, this is accomplished, winning is inevitable.

As part of the registration process, we want to ensure that you understand the obligations and commitments associated with accepting a position on a AUSC travel team. Please initial the points below to acknowledge your understanding of these expectations, then sign and date the last page when completed.

A. Registration Fee

The registration fee for the 2014-2015 season is \$500 (\$250 in Fall, \$250 in Spring) and a \$280 uniform fee if new to the club or if uniforms styles have changed.

Premier team fees are \$700.00 (\$350.00 in Fall and \$350.00 in Spring)

The registration fee covers the following:

- Illinois Youth Soccer Association (IYSA) US Clubs Soccer Association fees;
- Northern Illinois Soccer League (NISL) and Illinois Womens Soccer League (IWSL) fees;
- Referee fees for regular season games and State Cup referee fees
- Field rental, field operations and overhead costs, including: insurance, equipment repair/replacement, lighting, field maintenance, outsider trainer fees, mailings, website expenses, board insurance, coach licensing requirements and coach uniforms.

The registration fee must be paid in full in cash or by check made out to Addison United Soccer Club. Installment payments can be made by arrangement with the Club treasurer.

Players may not be able to play in games if fees are in arrears.

B. Uniform Fee

There is a \$280 uniform fee for players. The uniform and price consists of one home kit and one away kit. The kit includes jersey, shorts and socks. A training t-shirt will also accompany the jerseys, a back pack and a warm up. AUSC changes its home and away kits every two years to accommodate for growth in size and changes in fashion styles.

The uniform fee is due at registration.

C. Other Team Expenses

I understand that all parents will share in team expenses beyond the club registration fee noted above to cover additional fees to play in tournaments, indoor soccer sessions, referee fees for scrimmages and club fund raising fees. Team funds remain with AUSC should the team disband.

D. Financial Obligations and Payments in a Timely Manner

I understand that accepting a place on a AUSC team and completing the registration documents obligates us to pay the full registration fee of \$500 for seasonal year. It is my obligation to pay the registration fee in full, regardless of whether we later decide to leave AUSC prior to the end of the 2014-2015 season. Player passes for individual players will not be distributed until registration fees are paid in full.

I understand that failure to fulfill our financial obligations to AUSC will result in the player's pass being taken away to prevent competing in games. The player will be placed in "Not in Good Standing" status with AUSC which will result in the player's playing privileges being suspended until all contract obligations are fulfilled.

Should the player wish to be released (other than for season ending injury or a move out of state) or to transfer to another affiliation prior to the end of the seasonal year, the player/parents will be required to fulfill all financial obligations noted above before the change of status is processed.

E. Player and Parent Conduct

I am aware of, and agree to the Parent's Code of Conduct and the Players Code of Conduct in the Parent/Player Handbook and agree to abide by the requirements. Players will be subject to IYSA, US Club Soccer, NISL, IWSL, USSF and FIFA rules at all times, or will be subject to disciplinary action.

F. Other Club information and Requirements

I understand that since this is a competitive travel soccer environment, there is NO guarantee of minimum playing time.

There is a "24 hour No Contact Rule" in place after games regarding contact with a coach, face to face, via email, or phone after the game. I/we will follow the correct protocol if a meeting is desired for conflict resolution with the Coach. This must be submitted through the Director of Coaching.
