SAFETY ORTS:

Range Safety:

With the recent shootings and stabbings, remember to always be mindful of your surroundings. Pay attention and be aware of exits when you enter a business. Have an exit strategy. Practice with your carry pistol regularly, including changing magazines. The club has LTC practice every other Thursday evening (check club calendar for specific dates). This is a great opportunity to practice shooting while moving and using cover as opposed to just standing in the booth and shooting.

Safety refresher class:

Safety classes are required for ALL membership renewals. Classes for next year's renewals have begun. There will be multiple opportunities to attend a safety class both following the regular club meetings and at other scheduled times, to be announced. A safety class is required for each year.

First Aid for Gunshot Wounds:

Texas Law Shield Gunshot Wound First Aid course will be held on Tuesday, October 22nd from 6:00PM to 9:00PM at the TPPC classroom. This class covers proper use of tourniquets as well as other first aid techniques for trauma victims. Class is open to the public, members are encouraged to bring a guest. The cost of the class is \$39 for Texas Law Shield members and \$59 for non-members. Attendees are asked to sign up and pay in advance by going to the Texas Law Shield website, <u>www.gunlawseminar.com</u>. Walk-ins will be accepted.

EVENTS:

NRA Personal Protection Expo:

There will be classes offered (some are free, some have a fee) and exhibitors will be there to show you their latest products. In September and October, Bill Thompson will be doing a safety renewal class after maintenance is done for those who can't make a Saturday or Thursday meeting.

More volunteers are needed for lead pit cleaning. It is performed after the Saturday meeting. Please consider helping. If you clean the lead pit 6 times, you can get \$25 off your annual dues.

WHAT'S HAPPENING IN TPPC:
