# John Hoffman, Former Huron Sheriff, Dies <sup>1970</sup>

John L. Hoffman, 88, Elkton, the sheriff of Huron County from 1927 until 1930, died Friday night at Scheurer Hospital, Pigeon, after a lingering illness.

He was born January 28, 1881 in Ontario, Canada and came to Huron County as a young man. He worked as a blacksmith and farmer.

John L. Hoffman and Miss Aimee Gwinn were married in 1921.

Mr. Hoffman was a layman of the Elkton Missionary Church and life member and past master of the Frank W. Hubbard Lodge No. 476, F. & A.M.

Surviving are his widow, four sisters, Mrs. Elizabeth Gorom, Marion, Ohio; Mrs. Emma Brace, Orlando, Florida, Mrs. Matilda Snider, Elkton, and Mrs. Edith Rice, Gladwin, and one brother, Henry Hoffman, Dogwood, Alberta, Canada.
