Words from the Director of Referees

Thank you everyone for a great first week of game play. We are here for the kids and we need to cheer for them, not critique the referees. They are here to help the game go smoothly. They are human and mistakes. They may not see everything you see and many have never refereed before in their life but they have volunteered to help. They are doing their best. Please remember to CHEER LOUD, OFTEN, AND BE POSITIVE!

As coaches, we get excited, but we must remember to coach from the “technical area” which is one yard off the field and within the center circle on either end of the halfway line. As spectators, please remember to let your team coach lead the team. They volunteered their time and went through training. Coaches and parents should ALWAYS be off of the touch line (sideline) so the referees can see whether the ball is in or out of play. NO ONE should be by the goal!

Player safety is our main concern. No jewelry is allowed. Jewelry such as earrings, bracelets (excluding medical alert), necklaces, hard objects in the hair such as barrettes, bobby pins and even beads braided into the hair are not safe and CAN NOT be worn.

Each team is responsible to sit on the side of the field that is listed on the schedule. The home team (team listed first) sits on the north or east side of the field and the visiting team (team listed second) sits on the south or west side of the field. Unfortunately, the means sometimes we have to sit in the sun. Please bring a canopy or umbrella. It will be warm. Parents sitting and cheering from the wrong side of the field will be asked to move to the correct side of the field. THE REFEREE DOES NOT SET THIS POLICY. If you have a concern or comment, please direct it toward the BRYSL board, NOT the referee.

As parents, one of the greatest pleasures you have is watching your kids grow and have fun. Please enjoy this time with them and show them you're proud. Sit back, cheer loud, and let's watch our kids have a great time!

Picture Day

Home Team

If your team is listed first on the schedule, you are the home team. This means that you need to sit on either the North or East side of the field. We understand that this will mean you will be in the sun on some of the fields. Please plan accordingly with shade pop-ups or umbrellas. If you must sit on the opposite side of the field for shade purposes, you are only allowed to cheer, no coaching or excessive celebrating! Also, your child's water **must** be on their home side for water breaks, not with you under the shade.
