## UNIFORM LIST

**All pupils must have:**

### SCHOOL DAY WEAR

Black or Red outer jacket - crested version only  
 Black crested jumper (different fabrics available)  
 Black formal trousers or school tartan skirt  
 School Tie  
 Formal white long-sleeved shirts and ties (mid-October to March)  
 White crested short-sleeved polo shirts (April to mid-October)  
 Black polishable formal shoes  
 Plain black socks or plain black tights

### P.E. and GAMES

Crested school tracksuit \*  
 Red crested short-sleeved polo shirt, black shorts, white sports socks (to be worn for P.E. only)  
 Crested hooded top \*  
 Runners with non-marking soles for P.E. and Games

**Appropriate astro-turf shoes/rugby boots/cricket boots/sports shoes are required for each sport**

Items marked \* will be supplied in the school. In the case of Form 1 the tracksuit will be billed. Other items will be cash with order. P.E. teachers will arrange orders at the start of term.

All items of uniform except those marked \* and shoes should be purchased from the school uniform suppliers: **The Uniform Warehouse, Unit 3, Cranford Centre, Montrose, Dublin 4. Tel: 01-2830173**

This ensures uniformity of standards among pupils at The High School; the standard provided by our suppliers will be the standard applied within the school. These items are manufactured especially for the school and variations will not be permitted.

**All items should be clearly marked with the name and form of the individual pupil.**



## UNIFORM CODE

**Pupils and their uniform are expected to be clean and neat at all times.**

- **School ties** should be worn neatly and up at the top of a closed collar at all times.
- **Shirts** should be worn fully buttoned and tucked in during the winter uniform season. Summer polo shirts must be school-crested aertex shirts supplied by The Uniform Warehouse.
- **The crested school jumper** must be worn in school and at school events from a date which is announced in October to a date which is announced in March. In situations when jumpers are not worn, the school uniform shirt and tie must be worn neatly. Jumpers which are torn or scruffy or have seams ripped are not permitted. In cold weather additional non-uniform clothing worn during the school day - for example, T-shirts, singlets, and vests - should be plain white only and must be worn completely under the uniform, specifically, under the shirt. Long sleeved T-shirts may not be worn under short-sleeved shirts. It is not permitted to wear hoodies under or over the school jumper.
- **Trousers** are to be formal and black in colour. No colour stripes, panels or detail is permitted. No other type of trouser is permitted (e.g. jeans style, cord, track suits, weatherproof trousers, etc.). If a belt is worn it should be plain black only. Trousers, as with all uniform, are expected to be neat and clean at all times.
- Pupils must change back into either full uniform or school tracksuit after PE/Games or other activities which end at 4:00 pm.
- The **waterproof black or red outer jacket** with school crest supplied by The Uniform Warehouse must be worn by all pupils. Other extra-curricular items such as school-approved crested polo shirts, hoodies, or sports gear should be worn in association with relevant sports and extra-curricular activities, and may be worn en route to, and from, school. It is advisable that hi-vis vests should be worn by all cyclists travelling to and from school.
- **Shoes** are to be of polishable black leather, with black soles, no portions of another colour, and suitable for walking to and from school. Socks should be plain black. No heels or boots are permitted.
- **Hairstyles** should not be extreme or such as to attract undue attention: shaved heads (minimum length blade 3), unusually long or short hair, obvious hair colouring or bleaching are not permitted. Pupils are normally expected to be clean shaven.
- **Make-up** (including nail varnish) which is obvious should not be worn.
- **Jewellery** must be very simple – one ring and one small plain gold or silver-coloured metal stud earring in each earlobe only. No items of jewellery are permitted that limit the pupil's ability to engage fully in all timetabled classes (including PE/Games).

**Please note that all uniform (including black leather shoes) must be worn on the way to and from school as well as while in school. It is not acceptable for pupils to leave their uniform in school and change when they arrive.** Pupils must change back into uniform when leaving the school after PE, Games, or other activities which end at 4.00 pm. The school tracksuit may be worn after team practices which end at 5.30 pm but not at 4.00 pm. Pupils are not permitted to wear any other items over or on top of their school uniform.

**Pupils in breach of uniform regulations will be sanctioned and may be sent home. The decision of the Year Head in consultation with the Deputy Principals is final in all matters of appearance. If there is any doubt you should ask the advice of the relevant Year Head in advance.**
