What day and time will the show take place?

The show will take place on Sunday, December 8th at 10:00am and 12:00pm.

Your child will only perform in one show.

You will be able to enroll in the showtime that best fits your schedule!

Due to enrollment, some classes will be assigned a specific show time.

Performers should arrive a half hour before their show time.

Your chosen show time is subject to change depending on enrollment and your flexibility.

My child isn't attending the show. How will that effect classes?

Each class at Cary Gymnastics is about creating and learning skills that when put together forms a routine.

The class is NOT structured around the showcase.

Students enrolled in class but not participating in the performance will continue to receive a productive class setting.

The routine will be structured around their regular floor rotation for gymnastics classes.

What should my child wear for the show?

To keep costs down, you do not have to purchase a costume for the showcase.

We are asking all performers to wear Christmas/Holiday themed Pajamas.

Please be sure performers can safely perform their routines without any obstructions.

Girl's hair should be pulled back into a pony tail, braids, or a bun.

Are tickets required to see the show?

Yes, tickets are \$5 each if purchased before the day of the show or \$7 at the door.

Tickets are NOT needed for children under the age of 5 sitting on a lap, or children participating in the show.

Seating is general admission and first come first first serve.

All tickets are non-refundable.
