**A Note from Rick:** Another consistent market at TLA this week. That is said in general over for all our markets over the last couple months. The butcher market has been very steady with a slight increase since the first of the year, with cows being in the 50s and low 60s, Holstein steers in the low 90s on the top end and Mixed steers around \$120. Bull calves have also made a few positive moves in 2018 and seem very solid around \$100 the last several weeks. The Hay market has been very solid and has even started to get a little stronger in the last 2 weeks. We've still got 6-8 weeks to go before new hay will be made and it looks to be painful for buyers during that stretch, but hopefully things will ease up a bit when we get to the 2018 crop. The Dairy market has had a rough go in 2018 and has taken a major hit over the last month or so. I don't see this changing in the short term, but when we get through all these extra cattle on the market and the milk market picks its head up, I think it will be a totally different story. Looking forward to a great Draft Horse week and the first day of Spring! Things are starting to feel like Draft around TLA and the excitement is in the air. Come check out TLA!
