## Benefits

*OSHA requires that employers provide training to all employees whose work involves permit-required confined spaces (29 CFR 1910.146). This course is designed to provide the basic training needed by entrants, attendants, and entry supervisors to recognize, evaluate, and control the hazards associated with confined space entry. Course participants who successfully complete this course should be able to: define terms specific to confined space entry; identify current standards governing confined space entry procedures; demonstrate the proper operation of certain testing instruments and explain their limitations; and describe appropriate ventilation, personal protective equipment, and emergency procedures that are necessary for entry into permit spaces.*
