And do this, understanding the present time: The hour has already come for you to wake up from your slumber, because our salvation is nearer now than when we first believed. ¹² The night is nearly over; the day is almost here. So let us put aside the deeds of darkness and put on the armor of light.

Romans 13:11-12

Advent and Christmas simultaneously call the Christian to look back on the promise of Christ's coming and on his return. Christ's return has captured the imagination of believers since the disciples first heard the idea from Jesus himself.

Despite Jesus' clear statement that no one except the Father knows the day and the hour, Christians have often become overly interested in the precise timing of Jesus second advent.

Scholars can look back over the centuries and see how each generation were certain that they would see Christ's return while they were still

alive. Even recently people have dared to proclaim that they have figured out the exact date of the End. You may remember a man by the name of Harold Camping. He was a Christian radio show host who famously announced that the world would end on May 21, 2011. He believed all of the living Christians would be raptured after a great earthquake and the world itself would cease to exist on that exact date. Mr. Camping reportedly spent tens of millions of dollars he collected from radio listeners who believed in his predictions in order to spread the word across the world.


As you may have guessed, the world did not end that May. Stunned

by the absence of the apocalypse, Mr. Camping offered his next prediction of October 21, 2011. This prediction also failed to come true and so soon afterwards Mr. Camping ended his radio show on Family Radio network.

This cautionary tale of Mr. Camping is instructive. Christians certainly should believe in the of Jesus. return However, we have the interesting balancing act of living as if Christ could return any moment. with the humility to recognize that we have no way to predict the day of his return. The result is

that Christians must live firmly planted in this world, while at the same time living according to the ways of the kingdom come. I think this uncertainty in timing is intentional on God's part, because it keeps us engaged in the mission while not allowing us to be fully consumed by the here and now. As Paul concludes Romans 13:12, the response to our belief in the nearness of Christ's return is living a life on earth that is not one that has given up on the world, but one that has been and is still being transformed by heaven.




Annual Meeting


The Annual Meeting of Dawson Covenant Church will be held on Wednesday, January 22 at 7:00 p.m. All members are encouraged to attend this meeting.
