




A Day at the Park - Fragile X Awareness/Fundraiser Event





We ended up with 62 golfers and with a donation from Verizon, we have raised \$5,100 which was donated directly to FXAM.


Thank You to all those who donated, participated, and were otherwise involved in making it a fun day. A special thanks to the Liberati Family for making the trip to golf with us!


