**The act of Ordination** symbolizes a combination of God's call for a person to be in ministry, the congregation's affirmation, the recipient's dedication to ministry, and the blessing of the wider church. Ordination follows a process of discernment in the congregation.

We need to understand how we work as a team in the area of Ministry.

The roles:

1. **Lead Pastor** who has the responsibility to lead the Church in a Scriptural direction for the purpose of which the Lord has called the church into being.
2. **The assistant Pastor** is there to assist the Lead Pastor in guiding the Church in Teaching, Admonishing the Church in a daily walk with the Lord to accomplish the Lord's will in His Kingdom.
3. **The Lay Ministers** will be there to assist in Teaching, Sunday School, Discipleship classes, Baptismal Classes, help in Premarital Classes, officiate at weddings as requested, and preach the Word under the leadership of the Assistant Pastor and Lead Pastor.

### **Deacons**

The deacons will work under the Leadership of the Head Deacon, serving the Church in different areas assigned to the Deacon Work by the Church. The Head Deacon, the Lead Pastor and Assistant Pastor will give direction and assignment, in the area of Hospitality, Welcoming Newcomers, organizing different groups for service on a personal level, which will include volunteers. (People who would host people for a meal, or for the night when needed) Who would oversee the foyer that there will be order and be used as it is proper, will be aware of needs of the people in the church, meet that need, or bring it to the attention of the Pastor.

They will assist in preparing for Baptisms, Communion Services, and other area of service.
