Our library patrons are able to stream a curated selection of movies and TV series for free in the Easy Watching category. You can stream Kanopy from a variety of platforms: Desktop, Apple TV, Phones (iOS and Android), tablets (iOS and Android), Chromecast, Samsung Smart TV, Roku, Fire TV, Fire Tablet, and Android TV. We are excited to be able to offer this service and we hope all of our patrons are taking full advantage of it!


