FOURTH GRADE READING

The following goals are at the core of our Fourth grade curriculum. Foundational Reading Skills

- Demonstrates skills by applying grade level phonics and word analysis.
- Reads grade level texts with accuracy and fluency to support comprehension.

Literature

- Uses key ideas and details to summarize.
- Uses key ideas and details to infer.
- Understands varying text structures.
- Compares and contrasts ideas and knowledge in literature.
- Reads and comprehends literature independently at grade level.

Informational

- Uses key ideas and details to summarize and explain information.
- Uses key ideas and details to infer.
- Uses text structure and understands relevant vocabulary to comprehend text.
- Uses text features to integrate knowledge and ideas.
- Reads and comprehends informational texts independently at grade level.
