This 8-hour ServSafe food safety Instructor/Proctor course is designed to assist Family and Consumer Science Teachers in becoming a Food Safety Instructor/Proctor through ServSafe and the Illinois Department of Public Health. Topics to be covered include time/temperature abuse, foodborne illness outbreaks, relationship between personal hygiene and food safety, methods for preventing food contamination, the flow of food from purchasing to serving, procedures for cleaning and sanitizing, facility management, and sanitation management through the food code.

Once the FCS teacher becomes a Certified Instructor/Proctor, he/she is certified to teach the ServSafe curriculum and administer the ServSafe Manager's Certification exam. This will allow their students to earn the National ServSafe Manager's Certification which is recognized in the state of Illinois and meets the new 2018 law requirements.
