


Show Regulations

- ✓ Programs in Rings 1, 3 & 4 commence at 8.30am. Ring 2 commences at 9.00am
- ✓ Helmets must be worn in all events.
- ✓ Any horse misbehaving or not under thorough control may be asked to leave the ring.
- ✓ **Stallions:** Stallions must have bit in mouth in their respective classes.
- ✓ Stallions must be led or ridden by a person over the age of 18.
- ✓ Stallions are not permitted in hack or riding classes apart from events 109, 110, 113, 114, 117, 118, 119, 127, 128 & 136.
- ✓ Stallions must be double tethered.
- ✓ In the event of a competitor having entered classes in different rings, if classes are on at the same time, NO disruption to program will be tolerated, except at the Head Steward's discretion.
- ✓ In the event of a horse appearing to be too big or too small it will be at the discretion of the steward or judge to have the horse measured by the Society's Official Measurer.
- ✓ NO parents, spectators or unauthorised persons allowed in the arena (which includes all 4 ring event areas).
- ✓ All competitors must enter and leave the ring at a walk; **ANY** person infringing this regulation will be disqualified from the competition.
- ✓ In any flag or bending race, no rider will be permitted to ride more than two horses and must wear an approved helmet.
- ✓ Ribbons will be awarded as stated in the schedule.
- ✓ All spurs to be taped or have rollers removed.
- ✓ Official Measurer on duty 7.30 am.
- ✓ Participants in Registered classes will need to prove registration if requested.
- Exhibits which compete in Show Hunter classes are not able to compete in Open or Novice Open Hack classes but may compete in any relevant breed classes.
- ✓ Show Hunters are required to be correctly attired and equipped including plain leather bridle-wear – definitely no ribbon or bling type brow-bands. Hunter riders should be wearing a tweed type jacket and no bling to be sighted.
- ✓ Novice events are open to any horse that has not won first place in a novice or open hack event at any Royal.
- ✓ A fee of \$50.00 may be lodged with disputes in writing 30 minutes after completion of judging. The fee will be forfeited if the committee considers the protest frivolous
- ✓ Show reserves the right to test horse exhibits for prohibitive substances.
- ✓ Judges decisions are final.
- ✓ All required forms are available on our web page www.nimmitabelshow.com.au
- ✓ All 4 rings will stop at 12 noon for the official opening of the Show.



Prizes: Rug + 1st \$450; 2nd \$240; 3rd \$160; 4th \$115; 5th \$60

The "Nimmity Bell" show jumping pointscore is a competition run over 4 shows – Nimmitabel, Delegate, Dalgety and Bombala. The "Nimmity Bell" trophy is to be awarded to the horse & rider combination with the highest pointscore in open competition over 4 shows. This will be awarded at the completion of EA events at the Bombala Show.

- Only horses registered with the EA of NSW are eligible for the pointscore. Horses can only score in EA events in classes 1.10m or higher, the event has a total prize pool worth \$100 or more, the event is officiated by an EA accredited Judge and Course Designer. All entrants in these events will be eligible for the "Nimmity Bell Pointscore" regardless of the total amount of entries in one class.
- 2. A horse & rider combination can only score once at each show. This score will be their best placing from that show. If a horse fails to place in an event, it will score zero for that show. The points will be awarded as follows: 1st = 5 points, 2nd = 4 points, 3rd = 3 points, 4th = 2 points, 5th = 1 point, no placing yet eligible = 0 points. In the case of "tied" placings the points will be spilt, the same way as prizemoney.
- Horses must compete at all 4 shows to be eligible for the "Nimmity Bell Pointscore". The
 only exception will be if an official vet / doctor's certificate is presented to the official scorer
 indicating the horse/ rider's inability to compete at one of the 4 shows. The official point
 scorer for 2019 is Michael Green, (64546283).
- 4. Results will be forwarded to Michael for recording from the official Judge/show committee of each show and then allocated points according to the rules above. Any disputes regarding the "Nimmity Bell Pointscore" must be directed to the official point scorer to be dealt with. Official protest/s must be made in writing within 1 hour of the class being completed and must be accompanied by \$50.00 and presented to the Official Point scorer. All events are EA events and will be run in accordance to EA rules.
- 5. Please note: It is requested that EA summer dress standards apply for competitors at all four shows (no polo shirts shirt with tie or stock to be worn).
- 6. Overall prize money will be awarded to the top 5 place getters at the completion of EA events at Bombala Show.

Ring 1 – Show Jumping

- ✓ A single horse is allowed to compete in a mix of 3 show jumping events.
- ✓ All horses in graded events must be registered with the EFA,
- ✓ Prize money will not be paid unless cards are presented with entry fee in graded events.

- ✓ Riders an ride multiple horses in each event.


