



I have a few items to let everyone know about:

Teacher of the Month for February is Mrs. Rhonda in Pre-K.

Parents please remember that there will be no School on March 30th. The center will be closed for training.

Please be on the lookout in your child's classroom for signup sheets for parties for this month. We have St. Patrick's Day and Easter to celebrate this month.

Parents our sick policy is that we send home any child that has a temperature of 101 or higher. If your child is running a low grade temperature plus throwing up, loose stools, watery eyes, cough, or complaining of body aches we will call and ask for pick up as well. We ask that your child be out 24 hours without any more signs of sickness (without the aid of medication) before returning to school. We want to make sure that our staff and other families are staying as well as possible and just please ask if your child is running a temperature to please keep them home for the day.

Please remember from 7:45-8 am the lanes in the front of the building will be for Pre-K drop off only. Pre-k parents will be able to drive-up and drop off the children to the Pre-K teacher. All other parents will need to park along side of building and walk your children in.

Please do not bring in outside food. If your child has a food allergy we need a note from a Doctor on file. Notes need to be very detailed as well as have an expiration date. You will need to provide an alternate food as close to what we are having as possible. It needs to be already prepared and ready to serve to child.

No medication of any kind will be given to child without a Doctor note and/or a prescription. Notes from doctors need to be detailed with reason for, signs to look for if for teething, amount, how often, and an expiration date. Medication forms are only good for two weeks.

Please try to have your child here as early as possible so that they're not missing any of the day's main activities. Cut off for regular classes is 11 am unless there is a Dr.'s note. Pre-k cut off time is 8 am.

Parents Please remember that we are a smoke free environment this includes our parking lot.

Remember that tuition is due by Monday at 6pm to avoid a late fee of \$50 and all balance must be zero at the end of the week to return the next.
