A/V Restoration and Upgrade Plan

- Urban Electric has completed the installation of the replacement HDMI and ethernet cables
- Brewse worked with Best Buy to develop a 3 phase A/V restoration and upgrade plan

- ❖ Phase 1 Restore A/V functionality with upgraded equipment, including 82 inch TV, mounting bracket, and sounder (\$3,450). Best Buy has recommended commercial grade interface equipment.
- ◆ Phase 2 Install new outdoor speakers and integrate speakers with the rest of the system.
- ◆ Phase 3 Purchase a portable outdoor A/V unit with video monitor and outdoor speakers; integrate unit with the rest of the A/V configuration

Phase 1 - Completed and ready for Easter services with replacement of HDMI cable and ethernet cable connecting the Chapel to BHA building; installed Black Magic Ultra Studio integration box, new cables, new camera (\$1,222) new Boxcast appliance (\$300) in the Chapel to stream audio and video from Chapel to BHA; 82 inch monitor and sounder are installed at the BHA; Brewse is researching the functionality of the interface equipment to determine if there is sufficient value to justify the additional cost.

- ▶ Phase 2 expected to be completed before Easter so audio of services can be projected to deck of BHA building.
- ❖ Phase 3 concern from BHA staff regarding the storage proposed portable A/V unit
- Researching the streaming and recording services and events

Long-term A/V Objectives

- * Have portable capability to project service audio and video on BHA deck
- Capability to record Chapel events on mainstream media
- Ability to to stream Chapel audio/video on the internet in real-time or near real-time
- Implement a permanent speaker solution for the BHA deck that supports all other long-term objectives (see Phase 2 above)
- Procure and install a larger TV for the BHA room and reuse existing TV as part of the portable solution.
- Identify at least 3 service providers who will be trained on using all of the A/V equipment at the Chapel and BHA to record events and stream events to the web
- Ensure that all equipment is reliable, relatively easy to use and multiple individual are trained to use it.
- * Establish a fee schedule for the following services:
 - 1. Recording events
 - 2. Streaming events on the web
 - 3. Projecting events in BHA
 - 4. Setting up A/V equipment for BHA deck for overflow
 - 5. Setting

Treasurer Bob Porter

- Profit & Loss \$16,843 loss for the full year before adjustments.

 A loss of \$10,066 was budgeted.
- Revenues were \$4,445 greater than budget
- Expenses were \$11,221 greater than budgeted, primarily because of the roof (\$26,596) and a special assessment at the Royal James Unit (\$4,620). The non budgeted expenses were partially offset by less than expected outlays in technology, insurance and other equipment and repairs.
- Final payment (approximately \$50,000) for the roof is expected to be made from Endowment Investment accounts.

▶ Balance sheet shows currents assets of \$45,956, far exceeding current liabilities (less wedding deposits) of \$2,535. Balance sheet does not yet reflect changes for 2018 in other assets (line 2000) which will be recorded by the assonant in view of the 2018 stock market activity.
