Keller Speed Track Club sends athletes to state meets

The Keller Speed Track Club (KSTC) sent five athletes to a recent state meet and have eight girls competing in an upcoming state competition.

Athletes who qualified for the USATF Region 12 Championship track meet held July 9-12 in San Marcos came away with seven second-place finishes, a third place and a fifth place. The girls and their events were: Nissih Nanivazo, 8U 800m and 1500m run; Tayja Hebert, 12U girls mini javelin and 1500m race walk event; LaKeilah Gardner, 12U girls shot put; Brianna Mponzi, 14U girls 200m hurdles and 400m; and Isabel Van Camp, 14U girls 800m and 1500m run.

KSTC also advances eight girls to compete in the TAAF State Games to be held July 31-Aug. 3 in College Station, Texas. These athletes qualified at the TAAF Region 4 Championship track meet held at The Colony, where KSTC athletes had three first-place finishers, two second-places, six fifth-placers and two sixth-place finishes.

The athletes who qualified to compete in the TAAF State Games of Texas are: Nanivazo, 400m and 800m; Skylar Brazzell, 8U 400m; Bryce Brazzell, 10U 100m and 200m; Jayden Wagner, 12U 100m hurdles, 400m, and 4x400m relay; Gardner, 12U shot put and 4x400m relay; Mponzi, 14U 200m and 400m; Shauntel Frye, 14U 100m, 200m, and 400m and Van Camp, 14U 800m.

The KSTC is a competitive track and field team for girls ages 8-18, designed to teach the fundamentals of track and field and to develop health and fitness. The Head coach is Martina Miller and is assisted by Andre Davis and Shundrekia Stewart.
