Dear Neighbors:

We hope you enjoyed your summer. This month's meeting will be held on Monday, August 27, 2018 at 8:00 p.m. at Village Hall and we hope to see you there.

We ask that you advise your gardeners to follow the Village Code in relation to start times. The code reads as follows; work can only commence on weekdays between the hours of 8 AM and 5 PM and on Saturdays , between the hours of 9 AM and 5 PM. No work is permitted on Sundays.

With Hurricane season upon us, please take a moment to review the condition of the trees on your property. Arrangements should be made to remove any damaged or diseased trees as well as limbs and shrubbery that overhang the Village roadways, particularly at the corner intersections. A clear visibility triangle and ample standing area is critical for NOT ONLY OUR children's safety while waiting for the bus, BUT ALL PEDESTRIANS ALIKE.

In September National Grid will be heading up a program to upgrade the gas infrastructure in our area. The roads that will be affected during this project will include parts of Ivy Hill Road, Channel Drive, Barberry Lane, Wood Lane, Willow Road and Hickory Road. National Grid will notify the homes affected upon starting so that you are not inconvenienced during this project.
