- B. Spiritually:
 - 1. Isa. 59:1-2 – The scriptures tell us that our sins separate us from God.
 - 2. Rom. 6:23 – Subject us to death
 - 3. Eph. 2:12 – Man without hope.
 - 4. Rom. 6:16 – Bondservants of sin
 - 5. Rom. 5:3-11 – Then, one day, we hear that God has provided us with an avenue of escape.
