## **PUERTO RICO**

Established as a judicial district with Article I judges in 1917,<sup>1</sup> Puerto Rico's district judges were given Article III status in 1966.<sup>2</sup> The territory is assigned to the First Circuit,<sup>3</sup> and has seven judgeships.
