A few reminders from the May meeting:

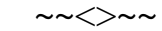
1. Voting for new officers will be at the June meeting.

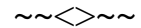

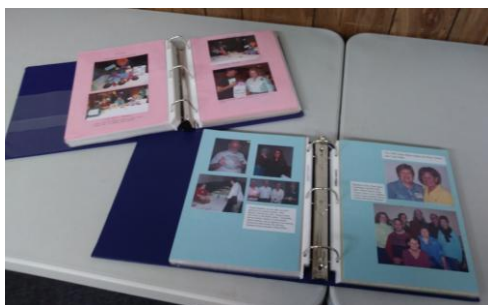
Happy Birthdays!

May Program: Rice Grain China

Jane bought these pieces in **Maison Blanche** or **DH Holmes**.

The process includes wet clay on a wheel, drying, cutting "rice" shape holes, then 30 applications of clear glaze till holes fill in creating that "rice" look when held to the light.
