

DENTAL INSURANCE

Dear Retirees,

I have been working closely with the Airline Retiree Benefit Trust to bring an affordable dental plan to our Pittsburgh retirees across the area and out of state. I'm now proud to announce a plan that recent retirees and spouses will be very familiar with from our airline days.

A new option is being made available to our IAM retirees who would like access to a group Dental Plan. Arrangements have been made with the Airline Retiree Benefit Trust (Formerly the Retiree Trust for former employees of US Airways, Inc.) to offer access to their Dental Plan. The Dental Plan is provided by Met Life and the benefits are similar to what is currently offered to retirees of American Airlines. George Kavros has been Chairman of this Plan since its inception in 2005.

Enrollment in the plan is open now and is available to retirees of any age. Attached are a Schedule of Benefits and an enrollment form. The rates for the Dental Only coverage are \$49.08 per single member per month and \$91.19 for a retiree and spouse.

Attached is an outline of benefits and an enrollment/election form. **You are only enrolling in the Dental Plan.** When you are completing the form, be sure to **check the box in each section that waives coverage for the Medical, Prescription Drug and Vision Plans.** The Airline Retiree Benefit Plan is administered by Gilsbar in Covington, LA. They will be able to answer questions for you or refer you to a Met Life specialist. Their telephone number is: 1-844-413-1989.

There is no waiting period for benefits for Preventive or Minor Care. There is a six month waiting period for Major Care benefits that covers issues such as bridgework, dentures, crowns, inlays and onlays.

IMPORTANT: If you currently are enrolled in the Cobra for Life Plan that was negotiated in the Bankruptcy do not enroll in this or any other plan as those benefits and premiums are very advantageous to you.
