WELCOME

Registering with the office:

Dear resident, unit owner or investor tenants old and new, who are new to the community. Please be sure to register with the office. Call to schedule a time to come in and review the rules and regulations with us. If you are a new owner, bring your deed and if you are new tenant, bring your signed lease.

There is still an ongoing problem with people who move into the community that don't register with the office. You will not be considered part of this community if you have not done the following:

- Come to the office and introduce yourself with a copy of your signed lease or new deed to the unit.
- Complete a Registration form (from the office).
- Once you have done that, we issue you a parking permit, pool pass, or laundry card (for \$5) if needed.

The office is opened from 9-5 Monday through Friday. We look forward to meeting you!

Leasing Program discontinued:

In January of this year, an inquiry into Natick Green's leasing process brought to the attention of the Board that there are serious risks and liabilities connected to the program. In February 2021, the Board voted to put the program on hold while additional information was solicited from Natick Green's attorneys and insurance carrier, Rodman Insurance. Rodman informed the Board that the Leasing Program is not considered a standard condominium complex activity and is not covered under our standard condominium complex policy. Both Rodman and our attorneys advised the Board to discontinue the program.

The Board discussed possible options to allow for the continuation of the program. A Motion that was made to resume the Leasing Program (with a slight modification) failed to pass.

The Board is sorry to inform Leasing Unit Owners of the end of the program. It is the Board's fiduciary duty to heed our attorneys' advice and act in the best interests of all Unit Owners.

With the good weather upon us, its important to remember a few things about the use of balconies:

- Plants and patio furniture are the ONLY objects allowed on the balconies.
- There are no bicycles, trash or drying clothes, blankets or towels allowed on balconies.
- There is a bicycle stand located in-between 30 and 32 Silver Hill lane and another located next to the laundry center on Post Oak Lane.
- Please remember to adhere to Quiet Hour rules when lounging and enjoying the balconies!



- Quiet hours are from 10:00 pm-7:30 am.
- <u>Do NOT THROW Cigarettes off of your balconies</u> If you do and Maintenance has to clean it up you will be fined.
 Also please respect your neighbors by smoking away from their windows.

For your safety, if you are having a police or fire department issue, please call 911, do not call the office.

If you burn something in your unit, please open the windows or slider door, do not open the door to the hallway.

If the fire alarm is going off in your building, please exit the building as soon as possible in case of emergency.


CAUTION CHILDREN WITH BIKES


