

The Military Sea Transportation Service (MSTS) was established in 1949 to consolidate into one unified command for the shipment of military supplies from the four separate services used during World War II. It was renamed Military Sealift Command (MSC) during the Vietnam War.

MSC ships are not USS but United States Naval Ships (USNS). Their ownership, staffing, and services will be explained by Captain McGoff.

Generally, it is all about logistics. There are five categories: Combat Logistics Force Ships, Service and Command Support Program Ships, Special Mission Program Ships, Prepositioning Program Ships, and Sealift Program Ships. In 2016, one of our Richmond Navy League bus trips boarded two MSC ships: USNS BRUNSWICK (T-EPF-6), Spearhead-class expeditionary fast transport and USNS WAT-SON (T-AKR-310), Large Medium Speed Roll-on/Roll-off Ship.
