



COVID-19 Rules & Regulations

- 1. Players can use dressing rooms providing social distancing is in place at all times (as of September 9, 2020)**
 - a. **NO** parents in dressing rooms
 - b. If your child cannot dress themselves, **please do so outside**
 - c. Players have **10-MINUTES** to dress, and **10-MINUTES** to undress
- 2. One parent/guardian permitted per skater**
- 3. One door for entry, one door for exit**
 - a. Please pay attention to signage for instruction
- 4. All skaters and spectators must sanitize hands upon entry**
- 5. All spectators must sign-in (contact tracing)**
 - a. Parents are to remain outside until skate starts
 - b. No congregating in lobby area
- 6. Upstairs viewing area is closed**
- 7. Non-Alcoholic Beverages permitted in seating area**
 - a. Players are permitted one clearly marked water bottle; no sharing!
 - b. **IMPORTANT** – If beverage cups are not thrown out after use by the user, we will revoke this privilege
- 8. Anyone presenting with COVID-19 symptoms are **NOT** permitted to enter the facility – let your instructor know**
- 9. Should rules **NOT** be followed, you will be asked to leave**

What are other rinks doing?

1. **Communiskate Regina** – No spectators; no outside food or beverage; dressing room usage
2. **Canlan Saskatoon** – No spectators for camp; no outside food or beverage; dressing room
3. **Rod Hamm/Latrace** – One spectator per skater; no outside food or drink; dressing room
