

The September 11, 2018 meeting of St. Albans Township was called to order by Chairman, Randal Almendinger.

All trustees and fiscal officer were present.

The minutes of the August meeting were read and approved as read.

The fiscal officer read fund balances to date.

Stan Robinson said he drove the roads in Stonestrow after the complaints at last month's meeting and it looks like a job well done to him.

Tom Frederick gave the August zoning report.

The fiscal officer presented a letter from the zoning commission recommending approval for a re-zoning application and text amendments to the township regulations.

Tom said there is a foreclosure in Stonestrow and the grass is getting tall. Bruce Lane said he will contact the homeowners association to see about getting it mowed.

Ray Cunningham gave the August Fire and EMS reports.

Ray said he would like to start a facebook page for the department, thinks it will be good PR. Trustees said that it was ok with them.

Ray said the department received a grant from the Shriners and the money will be used to purchase 4 MSA thermal imagers.

Trustees said they do not want vehicles parked in the bays or on the ramps of the fire station.

Randal Almendinger said the township was able to get salt for the winter thanks to Jean Morrison, over 300 townships didn't get notices for the ODOT salt bids.

The fiscal officer said our Medicaid number expired and we got notification before Labor day and the info necessary for a new number hasn't been submitted as it's been requested by the billing company and this is a time sensitive issue. Ray Cunningham said he will send an e-mail to all employees to get him the necessary info.

Bruce Lane said the road crew has been changing out a culvert across the entrance of Stonestrow and doing a lot of berming.

Bruce said we have a tentative date of about a month and a half out for tree trimming and need to get trees marked before leaves start falling.

Bruce talked about where to put a new township building.

Randal Almendinger made a motion to adjourn regular session.

Randal Almendinger said the results from the executive session are that Chief Scovell will resume his position immediately in a light duty capacity.
