Welcome to March, Lent and Holy Week -- 2020!

We find ourselves once again in the midst of the season of repentance. You may have already been introduced to this year's theme at the Ash Wednesday worship service; however, I want to take this opportunity to present to you the theme for our Wednesday evenings together that will take us from Ash Wednesday through to Easter Sunday.

I'm using as a basis for our Lenten journey a nine session Bible Study written by my friend and former coworker, Pastor Steve King entitled, **"One For All: Experiencing the Exclusive Claim of Christ."** Though it was originally written and intended for use as curriculum for Adult Sunday School, I am adapting it to guide us through this Lenten season. The worship schedule will look like this:

Ash Wednesday, February 26th, John 1: 19-51; **"Come and See!"**

Wednesday, March 4th, 1 John 4: 1-21; **"Testing the Spirits"**

Wednesday, March 11th, Acts 3: 1-16, 4: 1-22; **"No Other Name"**

Wednesday, March 18th, 2 Corinthians 5: 6-21; **"Made New in Christ"**

Wednesday, March 25th, Romans 10: 5-21; **"God's Own 'Exclusive'"**

Wednesday, April 1st, John 3: 16-36; **"He Must Increase"**

Maundy Thursday, April 9th, Ephesians 4: 1-32; **"The One for All"**

Good Friday, April 10th, John 14: 1-24; **"A One-Way Street"**

Easter Sunday, April 12th, Mark 8: 22-38; **"Not Ashamed of Christ"** (This is from the original materials but I will probably change the title and the text for Easter Sunday while still using the underlying material and theme to round out the series).

So, I invite all of you to join with your church family for the next five Wednesday evenings for soup at 6:00 p.m. and the worship service at 6:45 p.m. Our Lenten services normally last approximately 35-40 minutes. There are signup sheets available on the table in the Fellowship Hall to volunteer to bring soup or set up for soup supper or clean up after our meal together. Remember that if you don't like to drive at night, let me know and we will find you a ride so you can fully participate.

So, welcome to Lent and Holy Week as we walk together to the cross of Christ on route to our celebration of Jesus' resurrection from the dead on Easter Sunday -- after we enjoy an Easter Breakfast together and host an Easter Egg Hunt for our little ones ☺! Blessings, Jaynan
