Financial Overview

Due to COVID-19 the Parking Authority and the Park and Ride are still experiencing a major reduction in revenues. Parking Authority revenue for May was \$78,597 less than May 2019. Even though expenses were reduced by \$44,700 in May, net revenue was (\$33,530) compared to \$377 for May 2019. Year to date revenue for the Parking Authority is \$208,562, a (\$111,414) lower than year to date for 2019. Year to date net revenue is (\$14,733) compared to \$112, 259 in 2019.

Park and Ride revenue for May was \$2,399 compared to 20,844 in 2019. This is a reduction of (\$18,444). Expenses were lowered by \$8,058 which still resulted in a negative net revenue of (\$16,494) compared to May 2019 of (\$4,157). Year to date revenue is \$112,481 which is \$31,922 lower than May 2019. Year to date revenue is \$16,575 which is \$20,035 lower than it was in 2019.

Unfinished Business

- 2020 Budget: In process of being modified due to COVID-19.
- <u>Budget Comments from DLGS</u>: These will be addressed when the revised budget is submitted.
- <u>Library Contract</u>: Payment from the Library for \$10,000 for 2020 has not yet been received..

New Business

- **COVID 19:** Library is scheduled to reopen on 7/2/2020 along with indoor dining. This should increase the parking volume in the downtown area.
- <u>5 Year Finance Model:</u> The three 5-year finance models have been completed and available to present to the Commissioners. A printed summary of each model will be requested from Holman, Frenia & Allison prior to the presentation for the Commissioners to review.

Terminate Health Benefits for Future Retirees: A discussion took place regarding the feasibility of continuing the policy of providing health benefits to retirees who retire with 25 years of service. Because of the GASB 75 requirements this policy requires the Authority to carry a \$3M expense on its financials. In order to move the Parking Authority's financial position towards a healthier direction it was decided to terminate this benefit. Grandfathering the current retired employee who is receiving this benefit, Diana Kucharik. Motion to terminate the employment policy of offering post-employment health benefits to employees who retire with 25 years of service.
