



Rocky Mountain MX Series 2017 Updates and Changes

March 13, 2017

The sport of motocross is growing! We are excited to see the increase in rider turn-out on a local, Regional and National level. With this continued growth, it is necessary for us to make changes and improvements to RMX Series events. Our willingness to change allows RMX the ability to bring you quality, organized events with the main focus on providing a safe, challenging and competitive motocross series. 2017 Changes include class structure, Friday practice, fees and race day rules. Please know that these updates are meant to improve each event and make it better for everyone involved. We realize no one likes surprises, so please read carefully and be aware of the updates. We appreciate you racing with RMX and look forward to another great season.

1. RMX Series Admission Pricing: The following changes were made to help create a true “Racing” atmosphere. As stated above, we strive to be an organization for those who are looking for challenging, competitive motocross.

- General Admission: Event Admission passes will be charged to all riders and spectators beginning Thursday night when the gates open at 5:00pm, through the end of racing on Saturday. Please plan accordingly for this admission pricing. This is not an increase in gate fees, the change is all spectators and riders will be required to purchase their weekend wrist band (same price) when arriving at the track. Friday practice is race practice for the event, practice only bands will not be sold without the purchase of a weekend spectator band.
- Event Admission:
 - \$10.00 - ages 13yrs and up
 - \$5.00 - ages 6-12yrs (5yrs and under are free)
 - This is NOT “per day” it is for the entire event.
 - Please remember RMX is Cash Only at the track.

2. Friday Practice:

- Friday Practice is considered part of the “Racing Event”.
- Event Admission and camping will be purchased at the front gate when you arrive, practice bands will be purchased at the RMX registration trailer.
 - You will be able to register for practice and racing at the same time, if you prefer.
- Riders will be required to practice with the same skill level they race.
- Practice will continue to be organized in a block format
 - Big Bikes: 8:00am – 12:00pm (125cc & up)
 - Mini Bikes: 1:00pm – 4:00pm (85cc & below)
 - Supermini’s will be allowed to ride big bike practice if registered for Supermini and Schoolboy only.

3. Race Registration: RMX is committed to keeping our events organized and running on time. The following changes are to help us keep that commitment to you.

- **Sign-up closes** 15 minutes before first practice
- **Late Sign-up Charge:** \$5.00 per class – after 7:45am
 - Any rider that is not registered by 7:45am for an 8:00am start time, will be assessed a \$5.00 late charge per class.

4. Saturday Race Practice:

- Riders must be registered to race prior to practice.
- Transponders must be on the bike for practice.
- Riders must practice with their appropriate skill level, failure to do so will be subject to penalty.

5. First Moto Gate Picks:

- Gate picks for first motos will be selected by random draw in staging. Each rider will draw a pin for their gate position.
- Second moto gate picks will continue to be based on first moto finish position.

6. Class structure: The following changes were made to balance the skill levels and create more competition within these classes.

- Removed +40 Open
- Removed +50 Open
 - Added +40 Amateur
 - Added +40 Expert
- The goal is to create a competitive environment, lap times show that faster +40's belong racing together regardless of age. A fast +40 and +50 had similar lap times in 2016. Splitting by skill rather than age will put similar lap times racing together.

7. Series Points:

- Series points will be calculated “per moto” (Like Pro Nationals) rather than your overall finish position, riders will receive points based on their performance in each moto. This allows for more accurate scoring of a series, your hard work will be reflected per moto for year-end points.
- Race Day finish position and trophy pay-out will still be based on your combined moto score for the day.

We strongly suggest reading the 2017 RMX Series Rulebook to become familiar with the class structure, cycle limits and additional race day rules. This is available at www.rmxseries.com.

2017 RMX Series Event Info
New for 2017:
This RMX Series Event will begin when the park gates open, Thursday at 5:00pm. General admission will be charged for anyone coming to the event from Thursday at 5:00pm to the end of racing on Saturday. Please read below for pricing information.
GENERAL ADMISSION: Begins Thursday at 5:00pm
General Admission: Includes all riders and spectators 6yrs and older.
Ages 13yrs and up: \$10.00 - event pass
Ages 6-12yrs: \$5.00 - event pass
General Admission is not "per day". It is for the entire event.
PARKING & CAMPING: Thursday thru Saturday
\$10.00 per night - Dry Camping only
GATE HOURS: Entrance to the track is not available other than the posted times.
Parking is available north of the entrance gate if you arrive outside of operating hours.
Thursday: 5:00pm - 10:00pm
Friday: 7:00am - 10:00pm
Saturday: 6:30am - end of racing
EVENT PRACTICE - Friday 3-17-17
Friday Practice is considered part of the event for racers to get extra track time. You must practice with your racing skill.
Practice Registration: \$25.00 each rider - must have weekend wristband in order to practice
Practice Registration will be handled at the RMX sign-up trailer
Thursday 7:00pm - 8:00pm Friday: 7:00am through end of practice
Big Bikes Practice Times: 8:00am - 12:00pm 125cc & Up
Mini Bikes Practice Times: 1:00pm - 4:00pm 85cc & below
Supermini's may practice with big-bikes if they are registered to race Supermini and Schoolboy.

Thursday: 7:00pm - 8:00pm
Friday: 7:00am - 7:00pm
Saturday: 6:30am - 7:45am (registration closes 15 min prior to the first practice)
Late Registrations: \$5.00 late charge will be assessed for any sign-ups after 7:45am on Saturday for an 8:00am start.
SATURDAY RACING - 3-18-17
Race Practice: 8:00am (time may be adjusted based on weather and daylight)
Racing Begins: approx 9:00am immediately after practice
Riders must be registered to race and transponders must on your bike in order to practice Saturday morning.
TRANSPONDER RENTAL
All RMX events will use transponder scoring. You will pick up a transponder during registration and return it when racing is over. \$100 cash deposit or credit card number is required in case the transponder is not returned. Additional details at rmxseries.com
