The Sidney Township Board meeting held at Sidney Township Hall, 3019 S Grow Road, Sidney, Michigan on September 13, 2021 was called to order by Supervisor Peterman at 7:00 p.m. followed by the pledge of allegiance.

Aaron Christensen asked if there is a blight ordinance in place. Hillman Road properties look bad and should be checked out.
