# Bad Axe Florist, Bob Galloway, Dies

Robert Merritt Galloway, 59, prominent Bad Axe florist, died Saturday at Huron Memorial Hospital, near Bad Axe, following a short illness.

He was born Oct. 16, 1919, at Bad Axe.

He and Miss Doris H. Hart were married Dec. 17, 1943, at Bad Axe.

Mr. Galloway was a member of the First United Methodist Church of Bad Axe, a veteran of World War II, having served with the U.S. Air Force in the European Theater. He and Mrs. Galloway lived for a time at Port Huron and Livonia before moving to Bad Axe.

Mr. Galloway was active in a variety of business and social groups. He and his wife owned and operated Hart's Florist and Gifts for 25 years and more recently the Galloway Florist and Sweetheart Bridal Shop.

Mr. Galloway was a board member of the American Red Cross, a past president and board member of the Michigan State Floral Association, a member of the Floral Delivery and Telefloral Associations. He was also a member of the Michigan Retailers Association, a member of the Verona Hills Golf Club and the Broken Rocks Association.

Surviving are his wife; one daughter, Mrs. Pamela Biasell, Rochester, Mich.; a grandson; a number of half-sisters and brothers, as well as several nieces and nephews.
