In Joseph's Dream his brother's sheaves were bowing to his sheaf in a grain field.

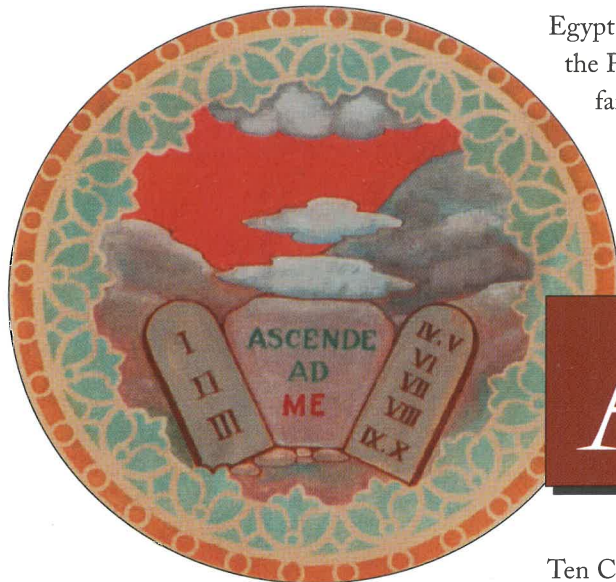

1 Kings 19:4-8

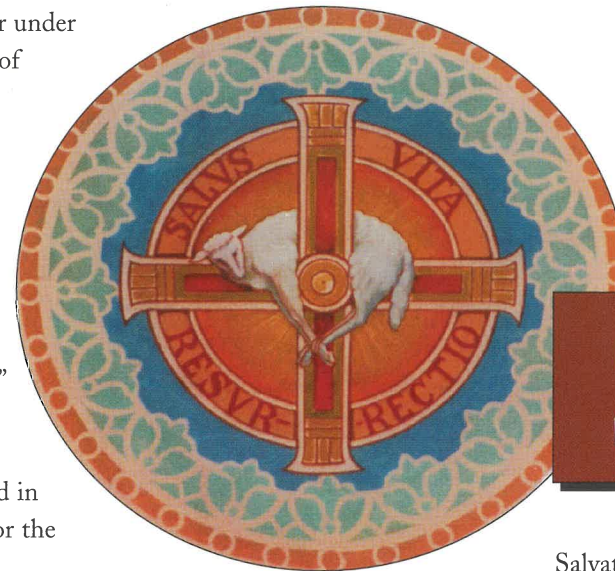
