

Specialist Lakeshia M. Bailey, USA (Columbus, GA, 23 years)

3rd Brigade Combat Team, 3rd Infantry Division, Fort Benning, GA

Died: 8 Mar 2010, Al Kut, Iraq

SPC Bailey died from injuries sustained in a vehicle roll-over. Her father served in the Army and their travels fueled Bailey's desire to serve. In 2006, she enlisted. She loved the U.S. Army and advanced quickly. Her family remembers her infectious smile. She left behind a husband and many other family members.

Private First Class Erin L. McLyman, USA (Federal Way, WA, 26 years)

296th Brigade Support Battalion, 3rd Stryker Brigade Combat Team, 2nd Infantry Division, Joint Base Lewis-McChord, WA

Died: 13 Mar 2010, Balad, Iraq

PFC McLyman died of wounds sustained when enemy forces attacked her base with mortar fire. After high school graduation, she enlisted in the Air Force, then reenlisted in the Guard and later served on active duty in the Army. She left behind her parents, two sisters and her husband. Her father remembers her as making a statement just by her presence.

Specialist Morganne M. McBeth, USA (Fredricksburg, VA, 19 years)

1st Special Troops Battalion, 1st Brigade Combat Team, 82nd Airborne Division, Fort Bragg, NC

Died: 2 July 2010 Al Asad, Iraq

SPC McBeth died of wounds sustained July 1 in a non-combat related incident in Khan Al Baghdadi, Iraq. She was a paratrooper, who lived to jump out of C-130s, serving as a combat medic. From a military family, McBeth had a brother in the Army who served two tours in Iraq.

Specialist Faith R. Hinkley, USA (Colorado Springs, CO, 23 years)

502nd Military Intelligence Battalion, 201st Battlefield Surveillance Brigade, Joint Base Lewis-McChord, WA

Died: 7 Aug 2010, Baghdad, Iraq

SPC Hinkley died of wounds suffered when insurgents attacked her unit in Iskandariya, Iraq.
