## From the Guidance Office

1. FSA (Florida Standards Assessment) Retakes will begin Monday, September 10 and run through Friday, September 28. Any student who completed the EOC-based courses in Algebra 1, Geometry, Biology, and US History, but were absent or perhaps not finished by the time the assessments were administered in the spring, will have an opportunity to clear this requirement. Letters went home on this past Friday alerting students of the test dates. Please be in school for the coming days to obtain your pass for testing. Some assessments are two sessions. Students must be present for both sessions in order to receive a score. See your Counselor if you believe you should be testing. Juniors and seniors will be taking the FSA Reading Retakes. Again, multiple sessions are required to receive a score.
2. Students in grades 9 through 11 received their Pre-SAT Practice book in homeroom on Friday, 9/7. Parents, ask your student for his or her copy. New this year is another opportunity for students in grades 9, 10, and 11 to meet the required benchmark for Algebra 1. Any student who has not already passed the Algebra 1 EOC and takes the PSAT math portion and earns a score of 430, will meet the graduation requirement for Algebra 1. Parents, please ensure your student takes the PSAT and takes it seriously to meet requirements for graduation as well as preparation for college.
